

1. Vaccinated Groups:

- people who have received one of the following vaccines approved in the State of Kuwait:
 - Pfizer/BioNTech (two doses).
 - AstraZeneca / Oxford (two doses).
 - Moderna (2 doses).
 - Johnson & Johnson (one dose).
- In addition to the above protected groups, those who have received two doses of one of the following non-approved vaccines in the State of Kuwait (Sinopharm, Sinovac, Sputnik), provided that the passengers arriving to the State of Kuwait have received at least one additional dose of the vaccines approved in the State of Kuwait.

2. Proof of vaccination:

- **People who are vaccinated in the State of Kuwait:**
- Vaccination to be verified upon arrival to the state of Kuwait via one of the following applications:
 - Immune.
 - Kuwait Mobile ID.
 - Kuwait Mosafer.
- **People who are vaccinated outside the State of Kuwait:**

Vaccination to be verified by presenting a vaccination certificate including the following:

 - Name as it appears on the passport.
 - Vaccine medicinal product.
 - Date of vaccination.
 - Certificate Issuer.

- Certificate contains QR code that can be electronically checked. If there is no QR code on the certificate, the vaccination certificate must be downloaded from the website of Ministry of Health in order to be approved.

3. Domestic workers:

- Domestic workers who are not protected as mentioned in paragraph (1) above, can be recruited by registering in the platform "Belsalamah".

4. Airlines must announce during the flight the necessity of activating the application "Shlonik" upon arrival to the State of Kuwait.

5. This circular note abolishes any previous circular notes contradicting the above.
